2014 AFFINITY, LA LONDE VINEYARD ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot, 8% Petit Verdot, 3% Malbec, 2% Cabernet Franc

KEY POINTS

- 20th anniversary of producing Affinity Cabernet Sauvignon from La Londe Vineyard (1993 was first vintage)
- 100% estate grown, single vineyard selection
- Just south of Stag's Leap, nestled in the Mt. George Foothills on the eastern side of the Napa Valley
- High density planting, cane-pruned site that bears just 2.8 tons per acre
- Volcanic, stony soils

2014 VINTAGE NOTES

- 2014 vintage is one of the finest in recent memory and possibly one of the finest in the history of winegrowing in the Napa Valley
- Hillside and mountain properties were actually less abundant than average in overall tons
- The acid and tannin structure was also exceptional making for wines that are balanced and layered
