

2014 HOWELL MOUNTAIN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Malbec, 2% Cabernet Franc,
2% Petite Verdot

95 POINTS "... Strikingly rich, opaque purple in color, with mulberry, boysenberry, blackberry, graphite and flowers, the wine is rich, chewy, full-bodied, multilayered, and just a sensational example of Howell Mountain. Sadly, most Napa Howell Mountain Cabernets of this quality sell for \$200-plus, but this one is available for under \$100, which is to the credit of the folks at Robert Craig. This is 25- to 30-year wine, although there's no harm in drinking it sooner."

2014 MOUNT VEEDER CABERNET SAUVIGNON

88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Merlot, 1% Malbec

95 POINTS "The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Mt. Veeder comes from a vineyard once owned by the late Robin Williams called Pym Rae (now owned by the Tesseron family from Bordeaux) that sits at an elevation of 1,800 feet. Blueberry, blackberry and cassis are all present in this full-bodied wine that displays the high-elevation bluer fruits that Mt. Veeder can provide. There is a floweriness and full-bodied richness, big extract, but great balance. There is no rusticity. This beauty should drink well for at least 25-30 years."

2014 SPRING MOUNTAIN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc

94 POINTS "The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon from Spring Mountain actually comes from the Crowley Vineyard on the steep slopes of the Mayacamas Mountains, planted at nearly 2,000 feet. The beautiful blueberry and black raspberry fruit, a cool, almost floral note, medium to full body and sensational purity and texture found in this full-bodied wine are classic Spring Mountain characteristics. This is a beauty of finesse and restraint, yet intensity. Drink it over the next 25 years."
