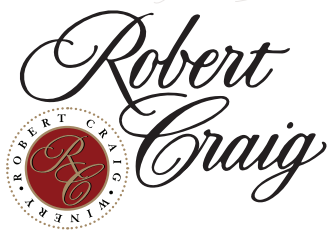

2015 GAP'S CROWN VINEYARD CHARDONNAY

KEY POINTS

- Sourced from the 138-acre Gap's Crown Vineyard in the Petaluma Gap on the southern end of Sonoma Mountain.
- Petaluma Gap's geography creates a fog and breeze pocket unique in the Sonoma Coast.
- Cool temperatures keep pH values low while preserving the fruits' natural acidity.
- Zero malolactic fermentation preserves the wine's naturally crisp acidity.
- Bottled unfined and unfiltered.

2015 SPRING MOUNTAIN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

KEY POINTS

- Distinctive Spring Mountain Cabernet blue notes – blueberry, boysenberry and exotic plum fruits; great weight, structure and velvety texture.
- The Crowley vineyard overlooks St. Helena from 2000 feet; rocky volcanic soil, varied hillside exposures, and moderate climate produce densely concentrated grapes.
- The mountain is cooled by afternoon breezes from the nearby Pacific Ocean, creating moderate daytime temperatures and cooler nights that allow grapes to ripen slowly without pushing high alcohol and sugars.

2015 HOWELL MOUNTAIN ZINFANDEL, BLACK SEARS VINEYARD

KEY POINTS

- Sourced from Black Sears Vineyard—officially the “King of the Mountain” as the highest vineyard site on Howell Mountain (2400' elevation).
- Both biodynamic and organic, Black Sears Vineyard is dry farmed, and the vines pruned in the old world style with no trellising.
- A powerful variation on a Howell Mountain, old vine theme, the wine is bursting with warm red stones, wild bramble fruits, and a dash of ground white pepper. Unlike any other Zinfandel in California.

VINTAGE: 2015 SIZE: 6 /750
