


2017 HOWELL MOUNTAIN **MERLOT**



The 2017 Merlot has a lushness and supple quality that make it a joy to drink even while young, though cellaring will improve the wine for the foreseeable future. Deep cassis, blackberry, iron, lead pencil and Howell Mountain stones exude from the nose and expand on the palate.



- Candlestick Ridge Estate Vineyard 2250' Elevation.
- Pure, white volcanic tufa soils provide excellent drainage while ensuring low yields and deeply flavored wine grapes.
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VINTAGE

- 2017 kicked off with a wet winter and warm springtime that had the vines cranking.
- Summer saw 2 heat spikes, but the actual ripening period for Mountain Cabernet was fair, cool and prolonged in September.
- 2017 was ideal ... until the devastating fires ripped through Sonoma and Napa counties.
- For the fruit already safe in the cellar, wines extracted easily and exhibited purity of flavor and structure with freshness and finesse.
